The form will be the first thing that appears when you log into the website. It will remain there until the next announcement is made. The form is also available in the ABOUT page and will remain there indefinitely.

Here's how it works.

Complete the form and clicks SUBMIT. You will receive a confirmation email that your form was submitted.

The CSP will receive an email with your name and contact info. Each CSP will receive emails only

for their area. The CSP will contact you and follow-up accordingly.



### Civic Engagement and Outreach Committee

This year the General Federation of Women's Clubs rebranded the Public Policy Committee and renamed it Civic Engagement and Outreach. Does that sound less intimidating than the former name? As Chair of this committee I hope the new label inspires you to join!

The mission of the committee is to engage GHWC members in grassroots projects that will create a better quality of life and foster a sense of community. Two subjects of interest to me are Women's Empowerment and Historic Preservation. Those two topics fall into the broader category of "Citizenship" which is one of the four pillars of the committee. The other pillars include Crime Prevention and Safety, Homelessness, and Military Personnel.

In the past members of Public Policy undertook the Holiday Cards for Troops initiative. If someone would like to continue this project please let me know. My focus, however, is designed to enhance the volunteer work I am doing with two other organizations, the American Association of University Women/Flagler and the Palm Coast Historical Society. Both of these non-profits are celebrating significant milestones.

The 100th Anniversary of the passage of the 19th Amendment allowing women to vote was celebrated on August 26, 2020. It is known as Women's Equality Day. Former Florida First Lady and Woman's Club President Mae Mann Jennings has been nominated to the Florida Women's Hall of Fame for her significant contributions to the Suffrage movement.

Local suffragist Alice Scott Abbott of Bunnell, FL has also been nominated for her tireless advocacy.



Their stories have been featured in local productions of "Women Won The Vote: How Did THAT Happen?." Their characters are played by GHWC members Patti Paukovich and Kathy Reichard-Ellavsky.

The second milestone is the 50th Anniversary of the Founding of Palm Coast by ITT on October 29, 1970. Our community has experienced tremendous change since its founding and the PC Historical Society is diligently working to document those events and keep our history alive.
