GHWC Policy as of 10/2017

This policy was revised in May 2023 to remove references to GFWC when the GHWC voted to end its affiliation with the Federation at the end of May 2023.

MEMORIAL GIFT POLICY

In the event of the death of a member or former member, GHWC will send a \$100 donation in the name of the decedent to a charity that has been designated by the family, as long as that charity has a mission compatible with that of the GHWC and falls within the following budget guidelines.

- Hold a current tax exempt certificate as a 501(c)(3) organization for a minimum of 1 year
- Have a presence in Flagler County and/or provide services/support to Flagler County residents (except International Projects)
- Organization's mission is in synch with one of our Community Service Programs: Arts, Conservation, Education, Home-Life, International, Public Issues
- Organizations whose mission/purpose is to advance political, legislative or religious activity shall not be considered for contributions

If no charity is designated by the family, the Club will send a \$100 donation to one of the organizations currently supported by the GHWC in memory of the deceased.
