GHWC 2025-26 Contributions Budget

The Budget Committee is presenting the proposed Contributions budget for the 2025-26 Club year. Members will be asked to vote on this at the September meeting; therefore, we ask that you take a few minutes to review this and, if you have any questions, we ask that you contact either of the Budget Committee Co-chairs, Nancy Carlton (407.421.7997) or Jenny Scott (630.272.8851) prior to the September meeting. Due to time constraints at our membership meetings, this will allow you to get your questions answered in detail.

With so many new members, we wanted to share the development process for these budgets. The committee follows the guidelines of its Budget Policy, which was developed several years ago and remains intact today. The one tenant of the policy that all should be aware of is that "no specific organization will be designated as the beneficiary of a fundraising activity organized and executed by the GHWC." All funds raised by these activities are attributed to the Contributions Income budget from which all allocations are made.

The process of determining projected income is that the Second Vice President, (who is also the

Fundraising Chair) in consultation with event leads, proposes income for each activity. Our budget philosophy remains that we budget income very conservatively and expenses very realistically.

All requests for allocations for charities are funneled through the appropriate CSP chair, who then organizes them, determines how those funds will be utilized by that charity and submits the requests to the Budget committee.

The Budget Committee then assesses how those funds will be used by the charities and prioritizes the need and, based on the projected income available, makes funding recommendations. Over the years, GHWC has provided funding to various organizations who no longer remain on our list. Again, it is based on the needs of the organization and impact they have on the community. The greater the need for their services and the greater the impact their services have, the higher they are placed on our priority list.

Just to reiterate, you are encouraged to review the income line items (again, we are conservative) as well as the allocations to the organizations and be prepared to vote on this at the September meeting. Any questions you may have can be answered by either Jenny or Nancy.


Did you know that you can download the events that are listed on the website calendar to your calendar? This is very handy so you don't have to enter each event yourself.

Here's how:

Locate the event and click on it to see the details. Then click the Save Event button. This will list the calendar downloads that are available. If you have an apple device (i.e. iPhone), choose iCalendar, if you want it add to your email calendar, choose Google Calendar, Yahoo, etc.

Seating arrangements for the monthly GHWC meetings!

While your process of checking in and getting your table number appears to be effortless, there really is a little bit of planning involved! We have several members who have pre-assigned tables to sit at. Reasons for these special seats can range from "You are the President, so you need to be at the table closest to the podium" to "You are a new member, so we want you to sit at the table with the Membership folks to be introduced!" Whatever the reason may be, here are the issues I would love to address:

- 1. Please **do not** sit in a chair at a table that isn't your assigned table. Even if you are simply perching in a chair to chat with someone, people looking for their seat don't know that you are simply squatting. If you are chatting with someone, please remain standing!
- 2. Please **do not** sit at a table you aren't assigned to. When this happens, people who are supposed to be at that table are forced to find seats at other tables, which then creates the endless game of musical chairs. This is a problem because people who need to be at certain tables are then kept from being there.
- 3. If you go to your table and find no seat there, please come back to registration and I will follow you to the table with our lists to figure out who needs to move. Do not just go sit down at a different table stop the cycle!
- 4. Whatever you do, **do NOT** put your table number back in the bag at the registration table after we hand it to you! If you do, you will have someone sitting in your lap for the entire meeting and that is just going to be awkward!
