During the last year (May 2020-2021) there has been a 25% increase of site visits over the previous year (1,964 visits) and in the last 90 days, the increase is 12% over the previous 90 day period (475 visits).

Many of our members are not very comfortable using the website and maybe having difficulty navigating to the various sections/pages. I will be delighted to help you; all you have to do is ask! Please let me know how I can improve our website so it's easier to use for all our members! Here are some tips / hints that you may find useful:

- ✓ As soon as you type the website's name (GHWomansClub.org), you'll be directed to the HOME page. Occasionally, a 'news flash' screen will pop up to alert you of something new or important. Click the X to close the pop-up screen.
- ✓ Did you know that if you hover the mouse (place cursor) over text or icon and it changes color or if a hand is displayed, you can click on it and see more information?
- ✓ Click the buttons on the left side of the main page (some are colored) to access information regarding that topic or section
- ✓ Most pages have a < Back button, click it to navigate to the previous screen
- ✓ The MEMBERS page has tons of information, such as Policies, Procedures, By-Laws, Forms, Documents, etc. The password protected 'Members Only' section is intended for our active members, it has information such as the Electronic member directory, Budget information, Treasurer's Reports, Meeting minutes, etc.
